ANALYSIS: ALC.14.00% R.S. 1.90g/1 T.A. 5.60g/1 PH. 3.42

VINIFICATION: Grapes were harvested at optimum ripeness and vinified separately in open fermenters using the punch down method for colour and tannin extraction. Components aged separately before careful blending.

MATURATION: Wine aged for 18 months in new and 2nd fill French oak barrels.

BOTTLING DATE: 08 December 2016
